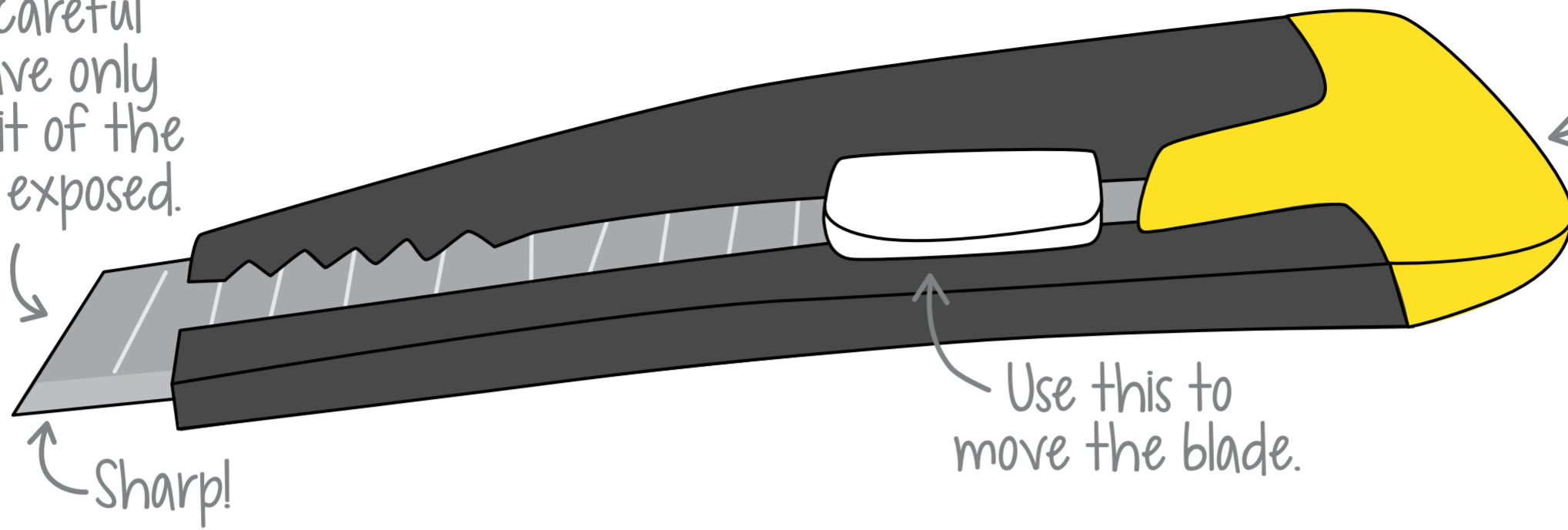


the snap-off blade

Be careful to have only one bit of the blade exposed.

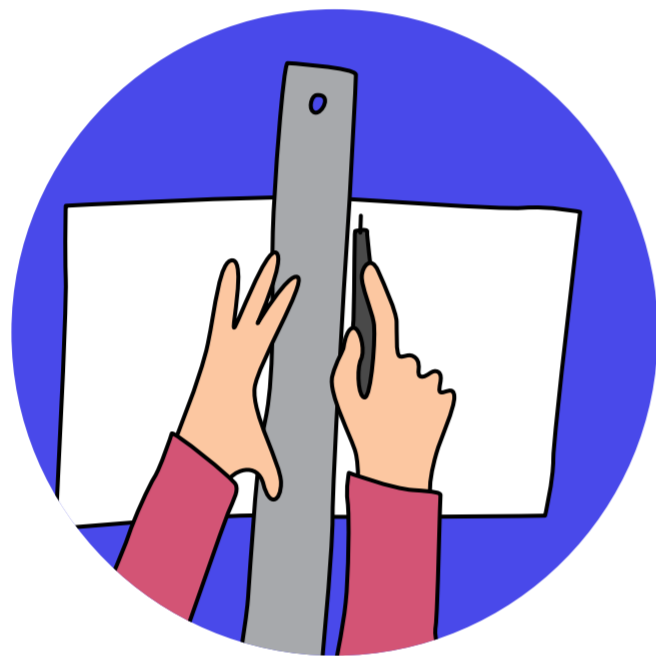


There is a slit to help you break the blade.

Hold like this.

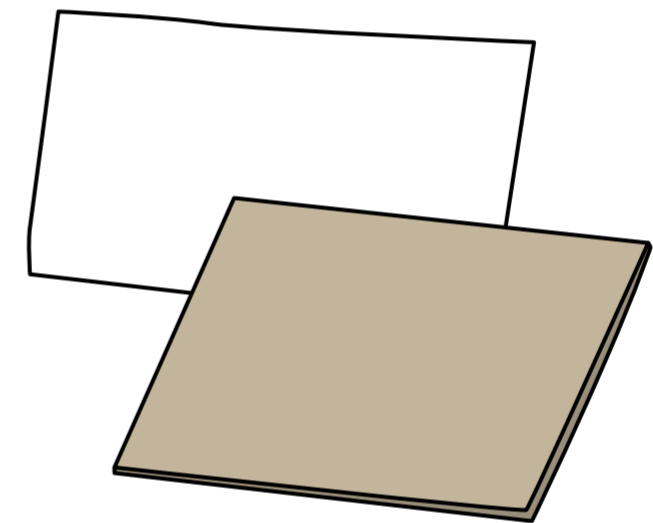


Stand while working.

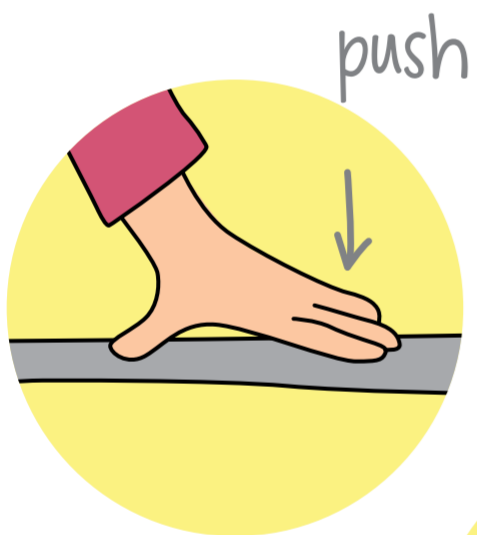
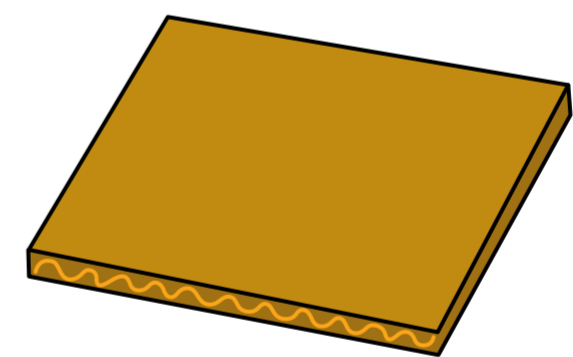


Work calmly.
